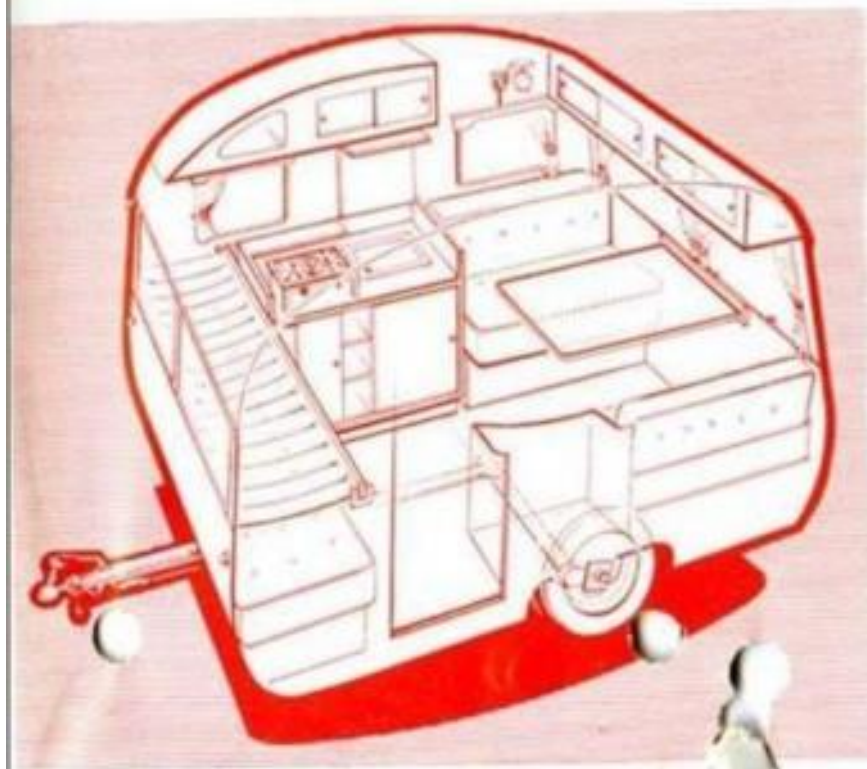

Or this? Quite a difference here—a compact lightweight suitable for cars over 800 cc.

Nevertheless, comfort isn't rationed in the Glen. There's room to sleep four people, adequate gas lighting and cooking facilities, a sensible wardrobe, double bed dinette, bed-settee and a folding bunk for junior.

Note also the "lowline" windows and storage space.

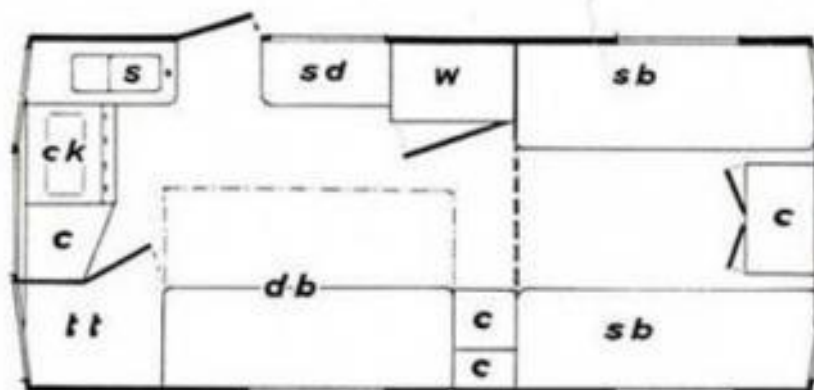
To complete the picture, the Glen has an all-steel chassis and steel torsion bar independent suspension to ensure smooth towing.

A settee bed with juvenile's folding bunk bed above, lie across the front of the Glen with kitchen unit on off-side. Cooking by gas hotplate with perspex sink contained within separate cabinet.

The large wardrobe stands to the rear of the doorway with a large double bed dinette occupying the rear.

Gleneagle Mk. VII

For you ? Think carefully. A Gleneagle ? Or are you more impressed by the Glenrosa ?

Whatever your final choice from the Thomson T-LINE range, all these models represent the classic embodiment of over fifty years of thoroughgoing Thomson experience, concentrated study and applied skill in meeting the requirements of discriminating caravanners. Typically Thomson, the Gleneagle Mk. VII is sturdily built and combines expansive interior comfort with quiet, well-mannered towing qualities.

Featured in the illustrations above, a large double bed-settee and two single beds with a roomy central wardrobe. The kitchen unit is cleverly installed across the width of the caravan at the rear end for maximum working space, and the kitchen equipment includes a gas cooker with oven, grill and two boiling rings ; a sink, draining board—and even a water pump—all fitted as standard equipment.

Both kitchen and toilet are situated well away from the forward compartment where the younger occupants can rest undisturbed in the two single beds. A folding partition separates the front section from the rear—a distinguishing feature of most Thomson models.
