






The second illustration shows the forward apartment which features two single bed-settees, king-sized wardrobe and, at the far end, a large locker which also serves as a dining table mounting.





Glen VII 10' 4-berth

ned interiors, attractively furnished


Even the smallest Thomson T-Line caravan offers a surprising amount of living space, as these illustrations of the lightweight Glen VII denote. Full-width "low-line" windows add to the impression of airiness created by the Glen's skilfully planned interior in which three adults and a child can be accommodated.

The interior view (upper left illustration) reveals the beautifully upholstered bed-settee and the well-positioned kitchen equipment which includes a gas hotplate and concealable Perspex sink with large storage cupboards beneath. Other easy-to-reach cupboards and shelves are fitted at eye level.

A single bed-settee, with juvenile's folding bunk above, is situated across the width of the caravan at the forward end, while a double bed-dinette and a large wardrobe occupy the rear section.


Suitable for towing by cars of over 800 cc. engine capacity, the Glen VII has an all-steel chassis and steel torsion bar independent suspension giving great stability when mobile.














Glendale 2/Eight 12'2-berth

Although exclusively designed for two people, the new Glendale 2/Eight can, nevertheless, seat six adults in comfort, for dining or entertaining.

Single bed-settees separated by a centre aisle run the entire length of the forward section, where a usefully ample locker at the extreme end serves as a firm mounting for the large dining table.

The kitchen installation is neatly arranged across the rear end of the caravan beneath the louvred, draught-free window; a gas hotplate, sink/drainer unit and lower storage cupboards being concealed in the handsomely simple kitchen cabinet.

The self-contained toilet apartment is located next to the large wardrobe— Thomson planning ingenuity ensuring that these, as well as the kitchen area, are suitably grouped away from the living quarters.

Attractively grained wall panels and furniture surfaces in natural finish plywood complement the richly-covered upholstery and fitted carpet. A well-styled caravan both inside and out, the Glendale 2/Eight offers holiday caravanners superb T-Line value at a very reasonable price.

Glendale 4/Eight

This extremely popular lightweight is equipped with four berths, two dining areas, a substantial wardrobe and good cooking facilities; the main kitchen equipment consisting of a gas hotplate, sink and draining board.

The double bed dinette in the front section forms a comfortable dining and living area which can be easily partitioned from the rear section, giving two separate apartments—a characteristic feature of most Thomson T-Line models.


The forward section double dinette has the advantage of a full-width window similar to that fitted at the rear—all occupants are thus able to enjoy an excellent panoramic view of their outside surroundings whilst relaxing in T-Line luxury.

The usual Thomson miscellany of storage spaces abound, with easily accessible lockers and shelves fitted at eye level and built-in under-cupboards incorporated in the kitchen unit and beneath the bed-settees.

The unique interior layout and comprehensive equipment of the Glendale 4/Eight puts this model on a par with larger, more expensive caravans; every inch of interior space being utilized to the best possible advantage.


The prize-winning Glenelg III 13' 4-berth

The Glenelg is a prize winner. In the 1963 Caravan Road Rally, this model won the First Prize Award for caravans costing under £400. The various reasons for this success are apparent when examining the Glenelg III, and we will gladly give you the name and location of your nearest Thomson T-Line distributor.

In the Glenelg forward section, a four-seat dinette converts into a luxurious double bed, while sleeping arrangements in the rear consist of a single bed with a bunk bed above-the latter forming a bed-settee backrest when lowered. These two beds can be curtained off at night to form a snug sleeping area where the occupants can rest undisturbed.

The kitchen unit containing a gas hotplate, sink, draining board and undercupboards is situated on the near side, and the self-contained toilet apartment is discreetly positioned in the rear corner furthermost from the forward dinette. A large wardrobe is included in the forward section and extra storage spaces are provided by eye level lockers, etc.



Glenalmond Mk. X 15'4-berth

One of the largest models in the T-Line range, the pace-setting Glenalmond Mk. X is a supreme example of all things Thomson. The kitchen is spendidly equipped, all essential items being neatly contained within an elegant cabinet. At a simple touch, this discloses the Glenalmond crockery cupboards, cutlery drawer, ventilated larder, gas hotplate, Perspex sink and draining board with a water pump alongside.

The forward apartment contains a double bed-settee and a fold-away coffee table, while the rear apartment features two single bed-settees and a large locker. A curtain partition separates the Glenalmond Mk. X interior into two roomy apartments whenever necessary.

To complete the picture, there's a large wardrobe, plenty of cupboard space and a selfcontained toilet apartment which occupies a discreet corner position.

Guarantee

The goods manufactured by Thomsons (Carron) Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") are supplied with the following guarantee, which excludes all warranties, conditions and liabilities whatsoever, expressed or implied by Common Law, Statute or otherwise.

Subject to the terms and conditions hereof, the Company guarantees to the purchaser that the goods are free of defective workmanship and material and undertakes to replace or repair, free of charge to the purchaser, any parts of the goods found to be defective. Any parts so replaced or repaired will be delivered to the purchaser at the Company's works only.

It is a condition of this guarantee that :-

- the purchaser shall, within seven days of the purchase of the goods from the Company or its authorised agents, deliver to the Company the appropriate form (supplied by the Company) giving the purchaser's name and address, the date of his purchase and the name of the agents supplying the goods;
- (2) when any defect is discovered, the purchaser shall forthwith send the defective goods to the Company for examination, properly packed and carriage paid;
- (3) the judgment of the Company in all claims shall be final and conclusive, and the purchaser agrees to accept this decision;
- (4) in the event of the Company rejecting a claim under this guarantee and receiving no satisfactory instructions within seven days thereafter from the customer as to the disposal of the goods, the Company may in its discretion either scrap the goods or return them carriage forward to the customer.

Under this guarantee :-

- (a) "Goods" (unless where otherwise expressly stated) means and includes new caravans or trailers or parts thereof manufactured by the Company. It does not include second-hand goods or tyres, gas or electric fittings or furnishings, or other goods not of the Company's manufacture.
- (b) "The Purchaser" means the retail customer who has purchased new goods direct from the Company or its authorised agents.

This guarantee, which is not transferable, shall remain in force for the period of twelve months following the date on which the goods leave the Company's works.

This guarantee will not apply to defects caused by wear and tear, misuse or neglect, or defects in goods which have been altered outside the Company's works without its written consent, or to goods which have had their identification marks removed or interfered with in any way. Moreover, the Company will not be answerable for personal injury or consequential or resulting liability, damage or loss, arising from any defects.

Important . . .

The issue of this folder does not constitute an offer, and sales are conditional upon terms of business and express warranty issued by the makers of the caravans, a copy of which can be obtained by request. THOMSON caravans may not be publicly displayed or exhibited, nor may they be entered for any competitive event, without the prior sanction in writing of the makers.

Standard equipment includes carpet, crockery, mattresses and curtains, but gas cylinder, regulator and toilet unit are not supplied. Although the manufacturers make every reasonable effort to conform to the specifications herein contained, these may be changed from time to time as improvements are embodied.
